DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES:		
<p>*WIC – Women, Infants, and Children – Eligibility is pregnant women, infants and children to age 5.</p> <p>*Maternal Health Program – RN, Social Worker, & Dietician visit with pregnant women discussing stages of pregnancy, expectation of labor & delivery as well as postpartum visits with newborn & mom. Social Worker discusses family dynamics, social needs, any crisis situations/needs and can connect with community resources when needed. Dietician will monitor nutritional intake and questions of mom and encourage and support breastfeeding.</p> <p>*Child Health Programs – Provide immunizations to children ages 2 months – 18 years. RN can provide in home nursing services/assessments to newborns, as well as any child with a nursing need/concern.</p> <p>*Developmental screenings are completed on children up to age 3. Lead screening and education is provided to all children in the child health program. Follow up and further assessment/evaluation is completed for all children with an elevated lead level.</p> <p>*HIV/STD testing – by appointment anyone can come into office for free HIV testing and counseling. STD screening and treatment is available by need.</p> <p>*Iowa Breast & Cervical Cancer Early Detection Program – federally funded program provides income eligible women with PAP tests, Pelvis exams, clinical breast exams and mammograms.</p> <p>*In-home Health Care skilled nursing services – RN provides in home nursing assessments, consultation, education, and hands on skill needed to clients.</p> <p>*CPR/1st Aid class – RN provide instruction through American Heart Association guidelines.</p> <p>*Child Care Nurse Consulting – RN works with childcare providers on health and safety recommendations, requirements.</p>		
FEES: CPR/1 st Aid classes are available by calling our office for a registration form. Cost is \$35.00.		
ELIGIBILITY: Many of our programs have different eligibility requirements/recommendations. For more information about specific programs please contact Webster County Health Department at 515-573-4101.		
AREA SERVED: Most of our programs and available within Webster County Maternal/Child Health Services and Child Care Nurse Consulting services are provided in Webster, Hamilton, Humboldt, & Wright counties.
